## Update for crisp and pen recycling.

Victoria and Violet would like to say thank you for all the effort and donations of crisp packets and pens for recycling. We have had to suspend the collection and hope to recommence the recycling scheme once the Covid 19 problem has subsided. The school has been collecting since June 2019 and have collected Approx. 9460 crisp packets weighing 19KG and 608 pens weighing 5.5KG. A total of 24.5KG of waste saved from landfill, this would equate to the same weight of 2381 toothbrushes. Thank you once again.
