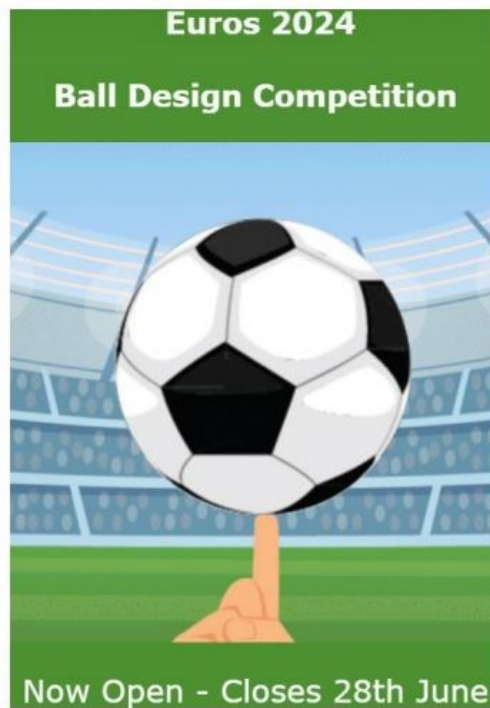

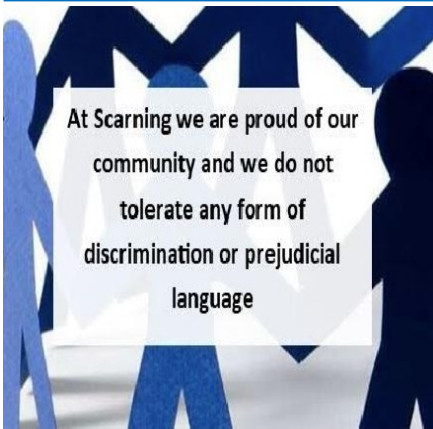

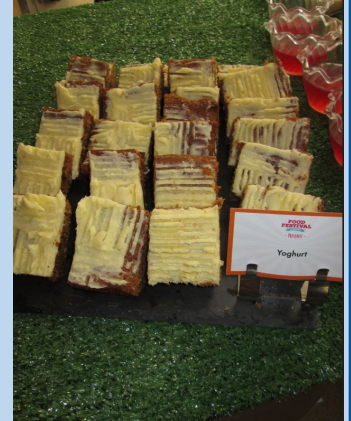


We would like to welcome Mrs Fitter who has started with us this week in the role of Midday Supervisor.

We have been notified that there will be no School Crossing Patrol on the 19th June pm and all day on the 20th June.

Please can we remind parents/carers that if you wish to take your child out of school for any reason other than a medical appointment, that an absence form is filled in prior to the absence. We do ask that where possible medical appointments are taken out of school hours but appreciate that this is not always possible. If your child will miss either a morning or afternoon registration we will ask for proof of the appointment—this could be a copy/photo of a letter or screenshot of an email/text message.





This week has seen our new catering suppliers Aspens start in the kitchen. The feedback from the children so far has been very positive, with the new pasta option being very popular! From September we are looking to remove the roll option from our menu (other than for trips out) as we have seen a significant decline in these being ordered and feel that with the new menu there is a greater hot choice available. Along with this we are keen for all

children who wish to, to have a hot lunch during the school day. We are holding a parent engagement session next Wednesday (12th June) at 3pm in the hall where you will be able to come in and sample some of the food available to children and discuss the menu with the kitchen staff.

Sports Day Friday 21st June 2024

9:30-12:00 EYFS & KS1 (Snowy & Tawny owls, 1B, 1S, 2S & 2T)

1:00-3:00pm KS2 (3C, 3AC, 4K, 4W, 5FH, 5BT, 6B & 6W)

For Sports Day this year the children will compete under their school houses. Teachers will inform the children what their House is if they are not aware. The colours of the houses are - Badgers White, Foxes Red, Rabbits Green and Moles Blue. We hope that children will wear a t-shirt of their house colour with their usual PE kit.

Unlike previous years there will be a dedicated area for visitors to sit on the field, please can we ask that adults do not call children into this area.

Start of the day

For safeguarding reasons we ask that pupils are brought to school at their normal time but that adults wait until the gates (at the bottom of the staff carpark) open at 9:10am. All visitors will be asked to sign-in and will be given a wrist band (this can take time so please be patient). Once you have a wrist band you can leave the site via this entrance and just show your wrist band when re-entering.

Lunchtime 12:00-1:00pm

Visitors are welcome to stay and eat a picnic lunch on the field in the dedicated area between the morning and afternoon sports. Pupils will be able to order hot dinners as usual. These will be eaten in the hall.

End of the day

All pupils will return to their classroom before leaving school from their usual exits. We are sorry but we will not be able to pass on any change of child collection arrangements - please let your child/childcare provider know in the morning if there is a change to your child's collection arrangements.
