Penalty Notice Fines for School Attendance are changing!

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after 19th August 2024.

Per Parent, Per Child

Penalty Notice Fines are issued to each parent, for each child that was absent. For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

National Threshold

There will be a single consistent national threshold for when a penalty notice must be considered by all schools in England of 10 sessions (usually equivalent to 5 school days) of unauthorised absence within a rolling 10 school week period. These sessions do not have to be consecutive and can be made up of a combination of any type of unauthorised absence. The 10-school week period can span different terms or school years.

First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for unauthorised absence the amount will be:
 • £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days
 • Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

Second Offence (within 3 years)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for unauthorised absence the amount will be:
 • £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days.

Third Offence and Any Further Offences (within 3 years)

The third time an offence is committed a Penalty Notice will not be issued and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrate's Court. Prosecution can result in criminal records and fines of up to £2,500.
 • Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on the parent's future DBS certificate due to 'failure to safeguard a child's education'.

Do you want your children to be more confident readers? Do you wish you could take children's books with you on your trips away without using space in your luggage?

This summer, our school is taking part in Serial Mash Summer, a fantastic summer reading challenge, aimed at getting children excited about reading.

Serial Mash is an online library of over 200 age-appropriate children's books with bright pictures and exciting story lines. It offers a wide range of books, fiction and non-fiction for children aged 5-11. With books organised into genres, browsing is simple. From adventure to sci-fi to mystery and more, there is something for everyone.

Over the summer, your child will have access to all of the books on Serial Mash - including non-fiction books from DK Learning - as well as interactive activities linked to the books. There are also online reading journals which automatically saves any Serial Mash book that your child reads, and gives you and their teacher the opportunity to write a comment.





As a school, we'll be aiming to boost the amount of minutes read by the children, which are automatically tracked within Serial Mash. The total minutes read for participating classes will be submitted by their teacher in September for the chance for our school and your child to win prizes!

How you can support your child

Your child will bring their Serial Mash login home, which you can use to log in to <https://serialmash.com/login> - if your child has access to Purple Mash, they can switch to their Serial Mash account using the menu in the top right-hand corner when logged in to Purple Mash. All you need to do during the summer is encourage them to read - the online platform will do the rest!
