Your child will be coming home tonight with their attendance for the whole school year. If they have achieved over 96% they will have received an attendance certificate. And for those of you who have children who have achieved 100% attendance for the year well done! They have also received a congratulation certificate.



Penalty Notice Fines for School Attendance are changing!

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after 19th August 2024.

Per Parent, Per Child

Penalty Notice Fines are issued to each parent, for each child that was absent. For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

National Threshold

There will be a single consistent national threshold for when a penalty notice must be considered by all schools in England of 10 sessions (usually equivalent to 5 school days) of unauthorised absence within a rolling 10 school week period. These sessions do not have to be consecutive and can be made up of a combination of any type of unauthorised absence. The 10-school week period can span different terms or school years.

First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for unauthorised absence the amount will be:

- £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days.
- Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

Second Offence (within 3 years)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for unauthorised absence the amount will be:

- £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days.

Third Offence and Any Further Offences (within 3 years)

The third time an offence is committed a Penalty Notice will not be issued and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrate's Court. Prosecution can result in criminal records and fines of up to £2,500.

- Cases found guilty in Magistrate's Court can show on the parent's future DBS certificate due to 'failure to safeguard a child's education'.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Care has been taken to enable parents to purchase clothing from stores of their own choice, but items with the school logo on can only be ordered from the school supplier - Birds of Dereham. Orders can either be made online or in store at Unit D, 13 Yaxham Road (behind Halfords).

Boys

Black or grey trousers

Optional for the summer term: tailored knee length shorts

White or light blue polo shirt

Royal blue jumper or fleece with school logo

Girls

Black or grey skirt, pinafore dress or trousers

White or light blue polo shirt

Royal blue jumper, cardigan or fleece with school logo

Optional for the summer term: blue and white checked summer dress or tailored knee length shorts

Footwear is expected to be suitable for normal school activities. Shoes should be flat (no raised heel) and black. Black trainer shoes are acceptable.

P.E. Kit

Indoor: Shorts (navy or black); T-shirt (white with school logo); Plimsolls

Outdoor: Tracksuit trousers & sweatshirt (dark coloured); Trainers

Long hair must be tied up for P.E. lessons and earrings removed or covered with tape (by the child themselves).

Hair should be of the child's natural colour, not dyed or coloured. Excessive hair decorations, nail varnish, make up and tattoos are also not allowed.

The fundraisers also run a pre-loved uniform shop, this holds a wide range of clothing so please come in and have a look. Open daily at afternoon collection—located on the path way to the main playground at the back of the school. (Entrance by Pre—School).
