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# Penalty Notice

Fines for School Attendance are changing!

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued **after 19th August 2024**.

Per Parent, Per Child Penalty Noice Fines are issued to each parent, for each child that was absent. For example: Sublings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

National Threshold

National Threshold There will be a single constaints high-radiated hereshold for when a greadly protoce mu method the single constaints high-radiated of 10 sensions (neurophy-represents to school days) of unauthorised absence within a sulling 10 school week period. These sensions do not have to be concastive and can be made up of a combination of any type of unauthorised absence.

First Offence The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for unsulfortised absence the amount will be - 1160 per parent per child paid within 28 days. - Reduced to 180 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

Second Offence (within 3 years) • The Second time a Penalty Notice is issued for unauthorised absence the amount will l • £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days.

Third Offence and Jary Turther Offences (within 3 genera) - The third trace a forces in committee 1 Freaby Noice will not be inseed and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrate's Court. Prosecution can result in crimical records and fines of up to £2,000. • Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on the parent's future DBS curtificate due to failure to safeguare a child's education.

# Reminder about our school uniform policy

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

We feel that the wearing of uniform encourages the children to develop the right attitudes towards school and that it gives them the sense of belonging to Scarning Primary School. Care has been taken to enable parents to purchase clothing from stores of their own choice, but items with the school logo on can only be ordered from the school supplier - Birds of Dereham. Orders can either be made online or in store at Unit D, 13 Yaxham Road (behind Halfords).

#### Boys

Black or grey trousers Optional for the summer term: tailored knee length shorts White or light blue polo shirt Royal blue jumper or fleece with school logo

#### Girls

Black or grey skirt, pinafore dress or trousers White or light blue polo shirt Royal blue jumper, cardigan or fleece with school logo Optional for the summer term: blue and white checked summer dress or tailored knee length shorts

**Footwear** is expected to be suitable for normal school activities. Shoes should be flat (no raised heel) and black. Black trainer shoes are acceptable.

### P.E. Kit

Indoor: Shorts (navy or black); T-shirt (white with school logo); Plimsolls Outdoor: Tracksuit trousers & sweatshirt (dark coloured); Trainers

Long hair must be tied up for P.E. lessons and earrings removed or covered with tape (by the child themselves).

Hair should be of the child's natural colour, not dyed or coloured. Excessive hair decorations, nail varnish, make up and tattoos are also not allowed.

The fundraisers also run a pre-loved uniform shop, this holds a wide range of clothing so please come in and have a look. Open daily at afternoon collection—located on the path way to the main playground at the back of the school. (Entrance by Pre—School).
